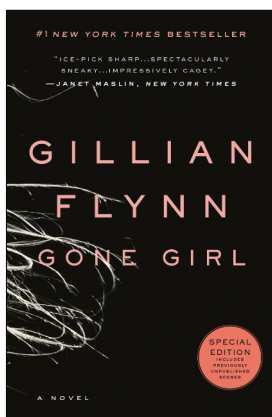


## **RECOMMENDANCE** Your Humor Style: **Edgy + Relatable**

You appreciate sharp insight into everyday life—with a dose of daring.

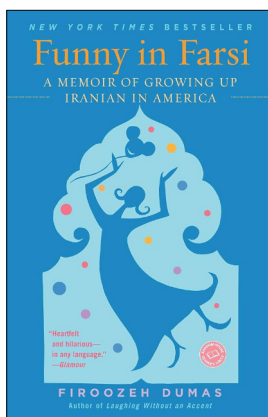

### Your Recommended Reads



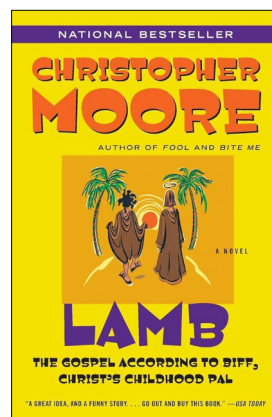
#### 1. **Gone Girl** by Gillian Flynn

#### 2. **Funny in Farsi** by Firoozeh Dumas

A memoir that balances immigrant awkwardness and cultural collision with bold humor. It's relatable, but never soft. Dumas confronts stereotypes with clever nerve.



#### 3. **Lamb: The Gospel According to Biff, Christ's Childhood Pal** by Christopher Moore

A satirical, irreverent reimaging of biblical backstories. Grounded in interpersonal comedy, yet unafraid to court scandal with sly wit.

#### Core Traits:

- Relatability: Truthful, recognizable characters and settings
- Edginess: Dark humor, moral risk, and boundary-testing

#### Look For:

- Real-life premises with an honest twist
- Humor that's comfortingly human and startlingly brave
- Writers who say what others won't

#### Avoid: **Eleanor Oliphant Is Completely Fine** by Gail Honeyman

Well-intentioned and emotionally resonant, yes—but its gentle tone won't satisfy your appetite for grit with humor.

#### If This Is You, You Might Say:

"It's funny because it's me—but it's edgy because it's real."
